2026 CENSUS

2026 is a Census of Population year. Invitation letters will be sent in early May requesting Canadian households to complete the questionnaire online. Completing the census helps ensure your community receives its fair share. Municipalities receive annual Municipal Revenue Sharing Grant from the Province of Saskatchewan using calculation based on census populations. Your response helps ensure our community receives the funding, services, and infrastructure it needs.

TOWN OF PILOT BUTTE
Notice of Intent to Amend Bylaw No. 02-2023

Public notice is hereby given that the Council of the Town of Pilot Butte intends to amend the Zoning Bylaw No. 02-2023 and adopt Bylaw No. 01-2026, under *The Planning and Development Act, 2007*.

INTENT:

To rezone a portion of the Hillside Park, located on Lafarge Street, from R1 – Single Detached Residential District to R2 – Urban Country Residential District to allow the development of **three large Single-Detached dwellings, with one dwelling on each lot**. The lands are legally described as Lots 10, 11, and 12, Block/Parcel 29, Plan 86R17347.

PUBLIC INSPECTION:

Any person may inspect the proposed Bylaw No. 01-2026 at the Town Office, located at 222 Diamond Place, Town of Pilot Butte, during regular office hours: 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. and 1:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday to Friday, excluding statutory holidays. Copies of the proposed bylaw are available for inspection at the Town Office.

REPRESENTATIONS:

The Municipality is open to accepting any representations from the public that state their concerns or comments regarding the proposed Bylaw No. 01-2026. Written, online, or any other representations shall be submitted with your full name and address no later than **March 2, 2026**, to the Town Office or email to planner@pilotbutte.ca

Council will hold a public hearing for the proposed Bylaw No. 01-2026 on March 9, 2026, at 7:00 p.m., in the Town's Council Chambers to hear any person or group that wants to comment on the proposed bylaw. TOWN OF PILOT BUTTE LEADERSHIP SCHOLARSHIP

The Town of Pilot Butte is offering one (1) \$1,000 scholarship to any Pilot Butte Grade 12 graduating student. The scholarship application will consist of an essay, video, and high school transcript submission, as well as an interview. Scholarship will be awarded upon a copy of an official tuition receipt from the post-secondary institution.

ELIGIBILITY

- ✔ Preference given to those attending a post-secondary institution in Saskatchewan within one (1) year of graduation.
- ✔ Students must be a resident of the Town of Pilot Butte.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- Submit a well-organized essay, including your contact information (e-mail, address & phone number). The essay needs to discuss:
 - Employment history, community and school volunteer work, extra-curricular and school activities. Please describe how your employment, volunteerism, & extra-curricular activities have provided a positive impact to youth leadership in the Pilot Butte.
 - What have been the benefits to growing up in rural/small-town Saskatchewan? What opportunities would you suggest that would make Pilot Butte a better place to live and work?
 - A short video on what youth leadership in a small town means to you.
- Submit a copy of your most recent high-school transcript.
- Submit with letter of reference.
- Attend the interview on the pre-determined date.

ELIGIBILITY

- Applications due by May 1, 2026
- Interviews will take place on a to-be-determined date.
- When applicants drop off or e-mail in their application forms, they will be assigned a time for an interview, which will be held in the Town Office Council Chambers.
- Please note: If no qualified applicant is found, the scholarship may not necessarily be awarded.

Town of Pilot Butte ATV Registration

What You Need To Know...

- All ATV's being operated on town property must be registered & display a registration tag provided by the Town of Pilot Butte.
- Golf Carts are *NOT* permitted.
- Use of the travelled portion of the roadway is permitted at a maximum of 30km/h within town limits.
- The Town recommends residents use the paved streets when accessing the most direct route to and from place of residence.
- Riders must be 16 years of age and hold a valid driver's license OR
- Riders age 12-15 must be directly supervised by an adult, or hold a valid ATV course certificate.
- All Terrain Vehicles are *NOT* permitted at any time on Town of Pilot Butte Public Reserve land (Parks), buffer strips, walkways, and crown owned land.
- Please follow and obey all posted signs.
- Please respect our residents and their right to quiet enjoyment of their property.
- To register your ATV please visit the Town of Pilot Butte's website: pilotbutte.ca/atv-registration
- The annual renewal fee is \$15 per plate. You must submit current proof of liability insurance with your payment.


The annual renewal fee of \$15 per plate can be paid at the Town office or sent by e-transfer to pbtransfer@sasktel.net







Pets

Reminder to Pet Owners:


• Pets must be licensed through the Town as per the Bylaw No.11-2017 Dog and Cat Control. The license fee is \$20 for neutered pets and \$40 for those not neutered for the lifetime of the pet. Licensing forms are available on the Town website: pilotbutte.ca/pets



- Pets must be on leash at all times.
- Please clean up after your pets on public and private property. This includes maintaining removal of defecation on your property throughout winter to ensure it does not become a nuisance come spring time/warmer weather.
- Please be respectful of neighbours by ensuring dogs are not left outside barking continuously.

Utility Notices & Payments

Utilities are billed on the first business day of the month for the previous month's usage. Payments are due at the end of the billing month. Interest will be charged at the rate of 1.5% per month on unpaid balances. Please plan accordingly when making online payments, as it can take up to 3-5 days to be received and processed.



Payment Options:

- Cash - at the Town Office
- Credit Card - online through OptionPay at pilotbutte.ca/optionpay or at the Town Office (OptionPay fees apply)
- Debit at the Town Office
- Online banking as a bill payment
 - **E-Transfer is NOT a payment option for Utility payments

Loraas Collection

Please ensure on collection days your Loraas cart is placed at the end of your driveway/property, not on the roadway—the Loraas truck arms can reach carts safely from there. This helps our Public Works crew provide optimal snow removal without obstructions.



Property Taxes

The property tax year is from January 1st – December 31st of the current year.

Property tax notices are sent at the end of May and are due December 31st of the year in which the notice is issued. Any amount unpaid by December 31st will be carried forward to the new year and will be subject to a 1.5% penalty on the first of every month thereafter until paid.



Book Review by Small Towns are the Life


The PARIS EXPRESS by Emma Donoghue

This book by a proven Canadian author is a gripping ride from start to finish. Filled with characters, some who really were on the Paris Express train of October 22, 1845, some historical persons who might have been on the train, and some richly imagined by the author, the book grabs you by the seat of your pants, and, like one of its characters, stuffs you into the nearest rail car and takes you along. You meet Madeline, the young reactionary, prepared to do what it takes to advance her cause; Maurice, 7 ½ years old, on his first solo train ride; Henry, the artist; Victor, the stoker; Guillaume, the driver, and a host of others. Luckily this is a book you won't want to put down, as there are many people to remember. (Who was it with the cleft lip under his full mustache?) The tale has a distinctly French flavor, the reader is transported to France and is able to taste the French culture of the day. Like the train whose story it follows, the action and the characters increase in tempo as the express speeds across the French interior.

The author masterfully carries you along – the pages are turning faster and faster and faster until... well, I won't spoil it for you. The whole book takes place in a single 8 hour day. You can read it in, at most, half that time. You won't be able to help yourself.

Emma Donoghue's imagination is truly inspiring. I haven't read all of her books, but the ones I have sampled have been very diverse tales of people in unusual situations with characters you enjoy whether you admire them or not. The prisoner in Room, the miracle in The Wonder, the nurse in The Pull of the Stars. I am eager to see who else is waiting for me in her other books.

Yay, Library, where I know Connie will be happy to order other titles for me. I recommend this book!

A Pilot butte Perspective:

Why Building Financial Structure Matters More Than Chasing Returns?

One of the most frequent conversations we have with people in Pilot Butte, and surrounding communities, has very little to do with markets, interest rates, or investment performance. It's a far more practical, and far more important, question: **"Where do I start?"**

This question rarely comes from a lack of motivation. More often, it reflects something completely understandable: **uncertainty.**

Some members of our community are just beginning their careers and want to establish smart financial habits early. Others are well into their working years and are looking for reassurance that they're making sound decisions. Many are approaching retirement and want clarity on whether they're truly prepared for the next chapter.

What we've learned through working with families and professionals in Pilot Butte is this: Financial confidence rarely begins with chasing returns. It begins with building structure.

Before investment strategies, portfolio discussions, or market analysis, the real foundation is understanding how the pieces of your financial life fit together:

- **How cash flow supports your lifestyle**
- **How savings habits create stability**
- **How risk is managed**
- **How future goals are prioritized**

In a world filled with market noise and financial headlines, this perspective often provides relief: you don't need to have everything figured out to move forward, you simply need a starting framework.

And that framework should reflect your life, your priorities, and your community.

This article has one objective: to clarify what **"starting"** actually means in practical financial terms.

1. Start with Clarity, Not Products





