PROPERTY TAX

Property Tax notices were sent at the start of May for the 2026 year. The discount period has been updated to a single discount period. Payments made on or before June 30 will receive an 8% discount (applicable on the municipal portion only), while payments made after June 30 will no longer qualify for a discount.

Online payments should be made in advance of the due date, as it can take 3-5 business days for the Town to receive and process the payment.

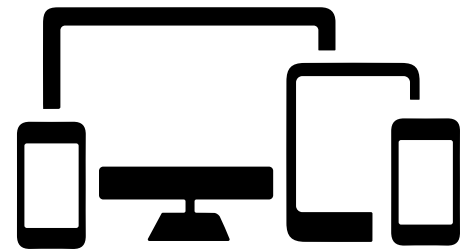

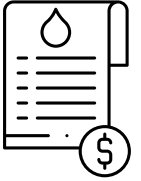

From the Town

Utility Notices & Payments

Utilities are billed on the first business day of the month for the previous month's usage. Payments are due at the end of the billing month. Interest will be charged at the rate of 1.5% per month on unpaid balances. Please plan accordingly when making online payments, as it can take up to 3-5 days to be received and processed.



Payment Options:

- Cash - at the Town Office
- Credit Card - online through OptionPay at pilotbutte.ca/optionpay or at the Town Office (OptionPay fees apply)
- Debit at the Town Office
- Online banking as a bill payment
 - **E-Transfer is NOT a payment option for Utility payments

Property Taxes

The property tax year is from January 1st – December 31st of the current year. Property tax notices are sent by the end of May and are due December 31st of the year in which the notice is issued. Any amount unpaid by December 31st will be carried forward to the new year and will be subject to a 1.5% penalty on the first of every month thereafter until paid. Discounts are available for early payments made by June 30th – please refer to the discount information on the Tax Notice.

For making online payments through your preferred financial institution, please search "Pilot Butte" as the payee and choose "Pilot Butte (Town) - Taxes" or "Pilot Butte (Town) - Utilities", as applicable. For tax account number use the number noted under Roll Number excluding the last 3 digits after the space in the Property Taxes Summary section. For Utility account number use the number noted under Account Number excluding the last 4 digits after the space in the Utilities Summary section.

Balances may take 24-48 hours to be updated after payments are made due to processing.

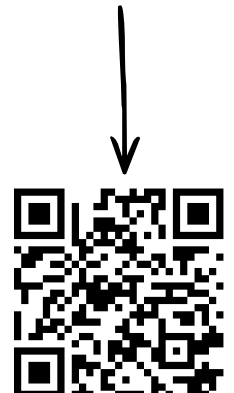

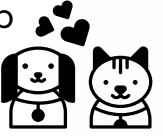


Summer Tips & Reminders

Pets

Reminder to Pet Owners:

Pets must be licensed through the Town as per the Bylaw No.07-2026 Animal Ownership and Control. The license fee is \$25 for sterilized pets and \$50 for those non-sterilized for the lifetime of the pet. Licensing forms are available on the Town website:

- Pets must be on leash at all times when outside your fenced yard.
- Please clean up after your pets on public and private property. This includes parks, pathways and on your property to ensure the smell doesn't become a nuisance as the weather warms.
- Please be respectful of neighbours by ensuring dogs are not left outside barking continuously.

Yard Maintenance

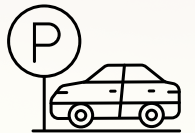
Yard Maintenance inspections will begin in June and continue on a semi-monthly basis throughout the summer in accordance with Yard Maintenance Policy 01-2020. Inspections help maintain a safe, clean, and attractive community by monitoring grass, weeds, and untidy properties. Landowners requiring maintenance will be notified and provided time to address concerns before further action is taken.

Boulevard Parking Restrictions waived from May 1 to October 31

From May 1 to October 31st, the 72 hour parking restriction on the boulevard is waived. This means legally registered vehicles may park on the boulevard in front of a property during this period. More info on the Town website: pilotbutte.ca/parking



ATV Registration

All ATV's being operated on Town property must be registered and display a registration tag provided by the Town of Pilot Butte. ATV registrations must be renewed annually, the renewal fee is \$15 per plate. More info on the Town website:

Landscaping & Rebate

When completing landscaping projects, please remember to keep landscape materials off roadways to help prevent safety hazards and keep streets clean. Residents may be eligible for a \$1,000 refund through the Homeowners Landscape Deposit Program if landscaping is completed within three years of permit approval. Homes built in 2023 have until summer 2026 to complete landscaping and apply for the refund.

TOWN OF PILOT BUTTE YARD MAINTENANCE POLICY

PURPOSE OF POLICY:

The Town of Pilot Butte's Yard Maintenance Policy was created so that residents can enjoy a safe and attractive community while also creating a predictable enforcement process. The Town of Pilot Butte recognizes the importance of the appearance and amenity of the entire Town and has implemented this policy to encourage landowners to keep their lots tidy throughout the summer months. This policy will adhere to the Town of Pilot Butte Bylaw No. 10-2022

SCOPE OF POLICY:

This policy is effective throughout the entire Town of residential, commercial, industrial, institutional, and vacant lots.

INSPECTIONS:

- Grass and weeds will be monitored by the Bylaw Enforcement Officer or delegate.
- Untidy and unsightly properties will be monitored by the Bylaw Enforcement Officer or delegate
- If, upon inspection, the Bylaw Enforcement officer or delegate determines a lot requires maintenance, the Town will arrange to have the lot maintained after following the notification process stated in Section 4: Notification.
- Inspections of residential subdivisions will occur on the dates stated in Schedule A: Inspection Dates, which are subject to change annually.
- Inspections of other untidy and unsightly yards causing a nuisance will occur as complaints are received.

Inspections will begin in June and continue on a semi-monthly basis throughout summer.

Landscape Deposit

Did you complete landscaping this year?

If your house was built in 2023 the summer of 2026 will represent your last opportunity to take advantage of the Homeowners Landscape Deposit.

The landscape deposit is refundable within 3 years of the date of the permit approval. This is a minimum landscaping deposit- all of the front, back and side yards must have the bare ground covered with either grass or landscape material to prevent water erosion, blowing sand, or the unsightliness of weeds. No other landscape features are required to qualify for the rebate, though we love to see fences, flowers, trees, bushes, water, boulders and anything else your imagination can provide. The Town appreciates all those residents who take pride in their yards and make them beautiful! Please note that your landscaping may not change the lot levels in any way that will have a negative effect on your neighbours' properties or on public lands.

When you are ready, send pictures of your yard from every perimeter to permits@pilotbutte.ca. I will make an appointment to come out and view the finished yard. Inspections are usually on Thursday afternoons. The Town will send a cheque in the amount of \$1,000 after the Council Meeting next following the inspection providing all requirements are met.





BYLAWS DID YOU KNOW?

Recently updated in 2026!

Animal Ownership & Control Bylaw No. 07-2026

A few key points to be mindful of:

- All pets shall be licensed through the Town of Pilot Butte. Fees for licensing are \$25 for sterilized and \$50 for non-sterilized pets.
- Dogs/cats shall always be on leash.
- Pet owners are required to clean up after their pet.
- Barking or howling for thirty (30) consecutive minutes or intermittently for one (1) hour or longer is considered a violation of the bylaw.
- Infractions are subject to fines and voluntary payments

Recently updated in 2026!

Operations of Vehicles Bylaw No. 03-2026

A few key points to be mindful of:

- From May 1-October 31 winter parking restrictions are waived, meaning boulevards may be utilized for parking of vehicles and recreation vehicles.
- Vehicles must be fully parked on the boulevard, not impeding the roadway.
- Vehicles may also park on a street where there is a constructed concrete curb, unless otherwise posted, for a maximum of 72 consecutive hours.
- Vehicles cannot be parked within one (1) meter from the centre of a fire hydrant.

The ATV (All Terrain Vehicle) Bylaw No. 03-2021

A few key points to be mindful of:

- No person shall operate an ATV between the hours of 11:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m. in the Town.
- No ATV shall be operated at any time on Town's parks, reserves, buffer strips, walkways, and crown owned land.
- A person has to obtain a Certificate of Registration from the Town if they wish to operate an ATV.

The Building Bylaw No. 07-2015

A few key points to be mindful of:

1. A building permit is required whenever work regulated by the Act and Regulations is to be undertaken.
2. No owner or owner's agent shall work or authorize work or allow work to proceed on a project for which a permit is required unless a valid permit (permit fee paid with final approval) exists for the work to be done.

***If you have undertaken a project once you are finished please remember to call the Building Inspector to have the final inspection completed so the Town may close the file.**

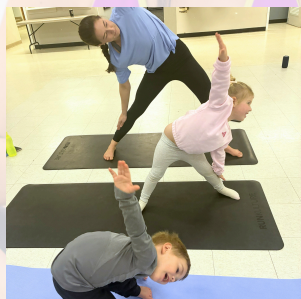
2026 Pickleball Tournament

Bloom & Bond Mother's Day Yoga

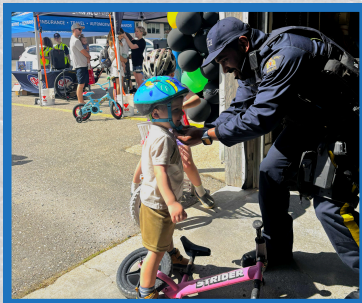

Book Review by Small Towns are the Life

The Drive Across Canada by Mark Richardson



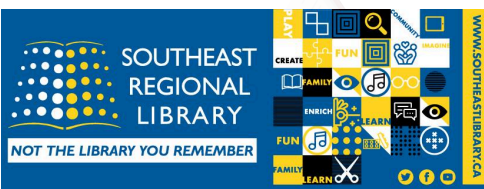
Small Towns are the Life

In this well-researched book Mark Richardson tells the story of the Trans-Canada Highway from its inception to its completion. But this is not some dry list of dates and places. This book is less about the actual construction of the project than it is the stories of the intrepid travellers, since the invention of motorcars, who have accepted the challenge of a drive across this wide and varied country, from forests and rocks to swamps and fields, to more rock.

Mark and a friend drive a Lexus, likely provided by that company, from East to West dipping the wheels first in the Atlantic, and finally in the Pacific. Pilot Butte readers will not be surprised to learn that the province of Saskatchewan was the first to complete its section of the route. That first iteration of the road was no highway, though. It was hard-backed gumbo, perfect for driving in dry weather and terrible when it rained.

The stories of those earlier travellers and their assorted vehicles are well-told, easily holding your interest throughout the book. This was a very enjoyable read, no laborious task, taking only a few hours to travel by arm-chair the thousands of miles across Canada.

I recommend this book, available at your local Pilot Butte Library.

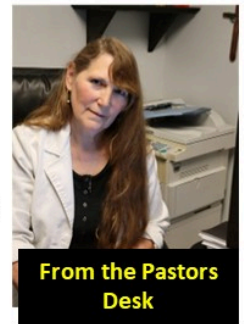

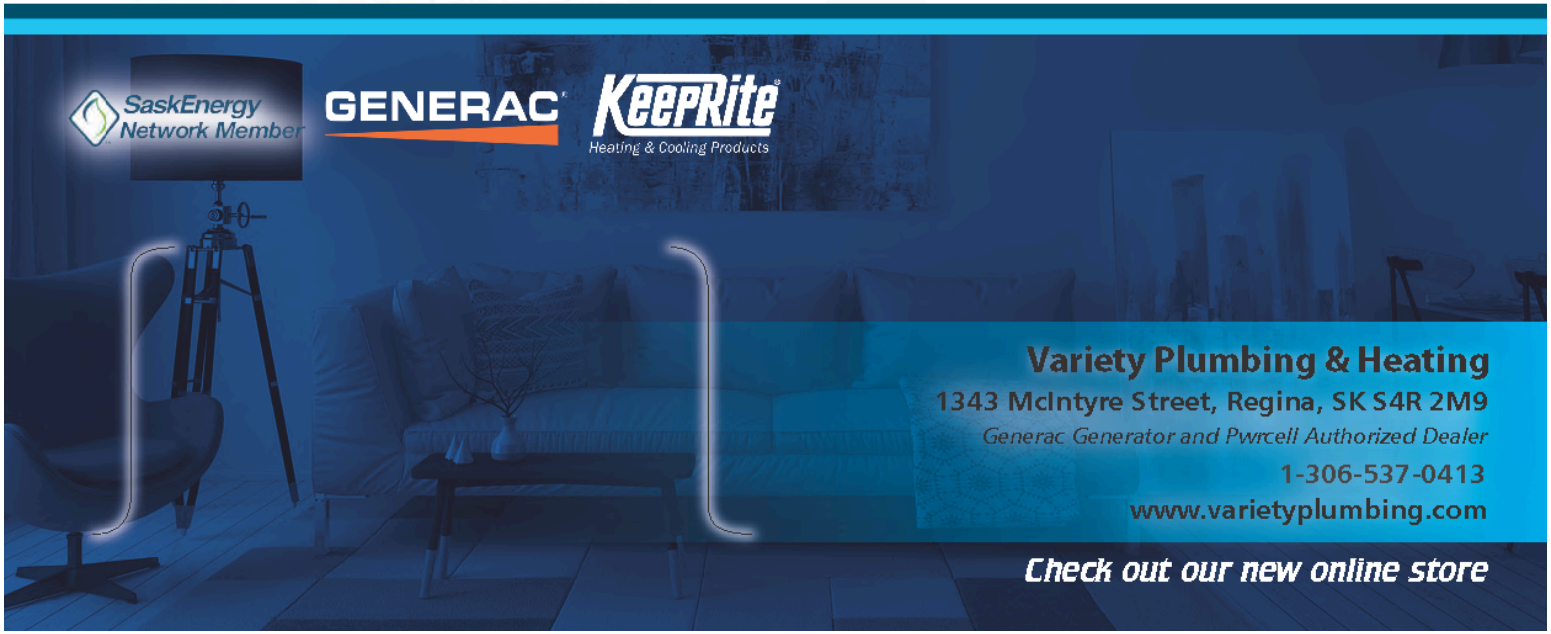
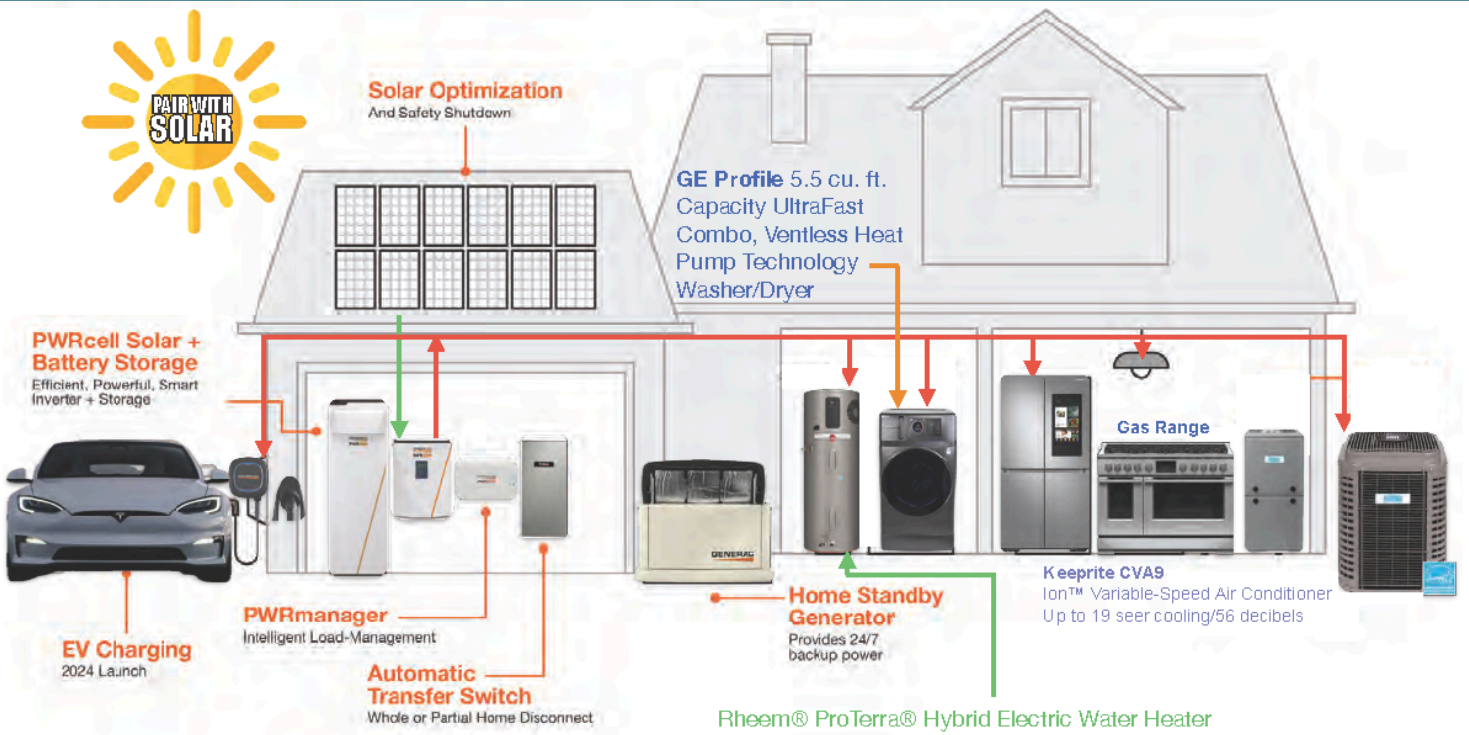
