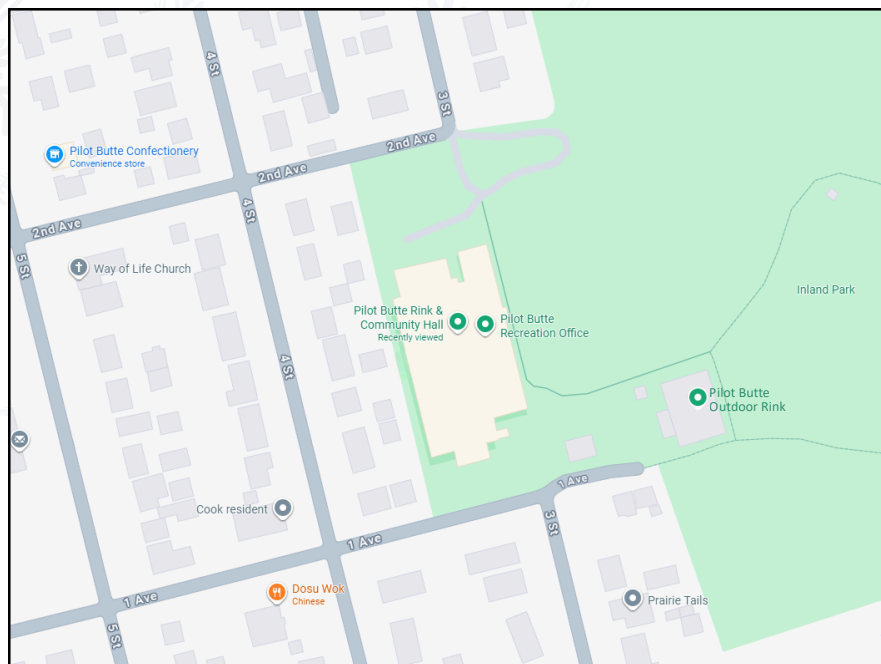

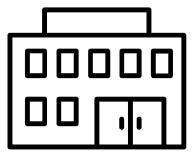

PARENT & TOT SKATE

This free skating time is open to toddlers and their parents/guardians/grandparents to come and skate in a quite environment.

SNOWSHOE BORROWING PROGRAM

With beautiful landscape and countryside near by, such as the White Butte Trails, this is a great way to get outside, explore and enjoy the outdoors!

- Snowshoes can be borrowed on a daily or weekend basis.
- There is no charge to borrow snowshoe equipment, but credit card authorization must be provided for the borrowed equipment.
- Snowshoe sizes and quantities available are:
 - Small - Up to 68 Kg (150 lb) - 2 sets available
 - Medium - Up to 90 Kg (200 lb) - 2 sets available
 - Large - Up to 113 Kg (250 lb) - 2 sets available

How to borrow:

- Snowshoe equipment must be pre-booked. Please contact the Recreation Program Coordinator at 306-781-6253 or Director of Recreation 306-781-3402, visit the Recreation Office or complete the form below to submit a request. Our Recreation Department will reach out to confirm availability and provide a Snowshoe Borrowing Agreement for you to complete the booking.

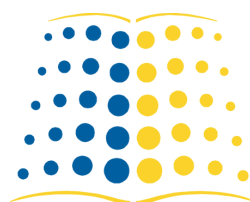

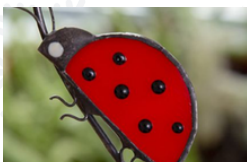

PILOT BUTTE BEAUTIFICATION COMMITTEE

The Pilot "Butte"ification Committee's mandate is to work in partnership with the Town of Pilot Butte, local businesses and other volunteer groups to develop a multi-year plan that focuses on sustainable, environmentally responsible green spaces and beautification plans. In addition to having a "greener" Pilot Butte, we hope to further enhance our community pride, help to reduce crime and promote tourism. In support of these goals, we are also committed to being active members of the national and provincial Communities in Bloom program.

Our initiatives include design and coordination of the hanging baskets around town, install annuals in the planters and flowerbeds at the Rec Centre, at the cemetery, with the on-going metal recycling bin fundraiser and participation in the Pilot Butte Cleanup Day. We also offer a Mother's Day hanging basket fundraiser, worked cooperatively with the Town to develop the Spray Park landscaping plan; weeding and maintaining the planting beds. We have assisted with town sign design and future plantings. We run a community garden box program and weed and mulch the food forest in one of the Plains Development parks.

In November 2025, our Beautification Committee had a vision to provide a beautiful Christmas tree for our community, with a tree lighting ceremony to gather the community together and celebrate the holiday season! The tree lighting event was hosted on November 30th with a contest to guess how many lights are on the tree.
