

LAST DAY TO PAY 2025 TAXES & UTILITIES IS DECEMBER 31, 2025

Payments must be received in the Town Office and processed by 3pm on December 31, 2025. Outstanding balances will be subject to a 1.5% penalty on the first of every month until paid in full.

Online payments can take up to 3-5 days to be received. Please plan accordingly to ensure we receive payments in time to process.

SNOW REMOVAL

Snow removal is prioritized based on the Priority Snow Removal Map, as per Snow and Ice Control Policy 01-2025.

Priorities are subject to change based on circumstances. When possible, please avoid parking on streets so our Public Works can move/remove snow effectively and efficiently.

Winter Tips



Add driveway markers to your property

Driveway markers are a great way to mark your driveway in preparation of winter for snow removal to help our operators effectively navigate the grader when removing roadway snow from in front of driveways. These can be found at local hardware stores.



Register for VoyentAlert

The Town uses the VoyentAlert notification system to keep residents informed on day-to-day notices, general and critical information. Examples of notices include planned snow removal, town events, town programming, planned maintenance, road closures, local emergency alerts, as well as reminders for collection pick up days. Residents can choose to personalize their preferences to specific topics of interest or receive all notifications.



Ensure you are aware of parking restrictions

Parking restrictions are in effect as of November 1st. No person shall park a vehicle on a highway or boulevard for any period of time exceeding seventy-two (72) consecutive hours. Only vehicles that are in daily use are allowed to be parked on the boulevard. The 72 hour restriction on the boulevard portion shall be waived from May 1 to October 31 of each year for legally registered vehicles.



Sand/Salt mixture available at the Maintenance Shop

A sand/salt mixture is available outside of the Maintenance Shop on Railway Avenue for residents of Pilot Butte to take for residential use.

Pilot Butte Priority Snow Removal Map



In 2025 the Snow and Ice Control Policy was updated in February 2025 to provide additional information on the snow and ice removal process and procedure, responsibilities and an updated map. Below is information from the policy outlining the responsibilities of the Town and Residents.

RESPONSIBILITIES Town Responsibilities

- 1. Town Council is responsible for the approval of the established priority areas, the level of service of this Policy and for providing an adequate budget to meeting these priorities and service levels.
- 2. The Director of Public Works is responsible for the establishment of the priority areas and the level of service of this Policy, and the strategic planning of the Public Works Department.
- 3. The Public Works Manager is responsible for the operations and planning of the Public Works Operators.
- 4. The Public Works Department is responsible for performing snow removal to the level of service described in this Policy and for providing feedback on the effectiveness of the Policy.

Resident Responsibilities.

- 1. Property owners are responsible for the snow removal on their private property and on the sidewalk adjacent to their property. Private snow removal should be carried out in such a way as to not negatively impact other property owners or hinder the Town's snow removal efforts.
- 2. Snow and ice placed on municipal streets, sidewalks, pathways, or parking lots by individuals or companies is prohibited.
- 3. Covering or blocking fire hydrants with snow is prohibited.
- 4. Vehicles in regular daily use may be parked on the streets for up to 72 hours. Residents are encouraged to avoid all on-street parking during/after a snow event.
- 5. Vehicles, trailers and any other items stored or otherwise parked are prohibited from parking on boulevards from November 1st to April 30th.
- 6. Residents are encouraged to use flexible driveway marks to mark their driveways and yards. Materials such as rebar, cinder blocks, rocks, concrete blocks or any other immovable material is prohibited.
